// Factorial of a number using JavaScript

```
var num = 5;           // Let the input number is 5
if (num < 0)
{
    console.log('Error');
}
else if (num === 0)
{
    console.log(`The factorial of ${num} is 1.`);
}

// if number is positive
else
{
    let fact = 1;
    for (i = 1; i <= num; i++)
    {
        fact *= i;
    }
    console.log(fact);
}
```

** tag** : The tag is use in HTML to specify the font face, font size, and color of text.

<div> tag : The <div> tag defines a division or a section in an HTML document. It is use as a container for HTML elements, which is then styled with CSS or manipulated with JavaScript.

<frame> tag : The <frame> tag is use in HTML to define one particular window (frame) within a <frameset>. It is use to divide the web browser window into multiple sections where each section can be loaded separately.

<frameset> tag : The <frameset> tag is use in HTML to define a frameset. It is use to specify the number of rows and columns in frameset with their pixel of spaces.

<center> tag : The <center> tag is use in HTML to align text in Center position.
